



## 2026 Annual Watershed Conference: Sponsorship Opportunities

The Hudson River Watershed Alliance's 2026 conference will focus on planning and partnerships that support our shared waters.

At this year's Annual Watershed Conference, we will share strategies and case studies of collaborative projects that support healthy, resilient watershed communities. The conference will have two components: **a virtual session via webinar** (to be scheduled) and an **in-person session on Tuesday, October 27** from 9 am to 3 pm at the Henry A.
